ABOUT

Catholic Charities Homelessness Prevention Program (HPP) provides eviction prevention support through rental assistance for back rent, security deposits, information, and referral to appropriate community agencies. As a lead agency in the Family Eviction Prevention Collaborative (FEPCO) of San Francisco, Catholic Charities represents a cohesive community of service providers that streamline the rental assistance intake process for low-income, at-risk families and individuals in San Francisco. Last year, HPP paid a total of \$1,971,000 for back rent and security deposits. Clients contributed as they were able, demonstrating their commitment to self-sufficiency.

Through the program, clients may receive assistance developing payment and budget plans.
