Located in San Francisco's lower Mission residential neighborhood, Catholic Charities 10th & Mission Family Housing and Edith Witt Community nourish and support a strong community where seniors and families thrive. Families residing at 10th & Mission have access to a powerful combination of affordable housing, accessible childcare, case management, and family support services at a single site; while seniors living next door at Edith Witt receive residential, financial, and social services that help them age in place in a safe, secure environment. The programs foster stability and are models for how integrated, concentrated resources can change lives and break the cycles of poverty.
