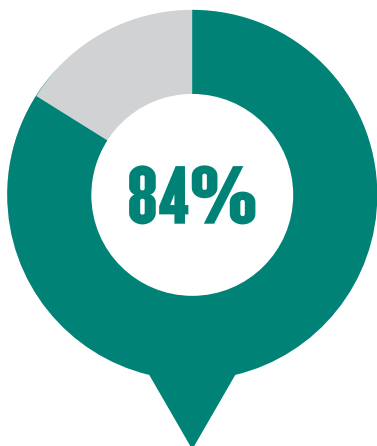

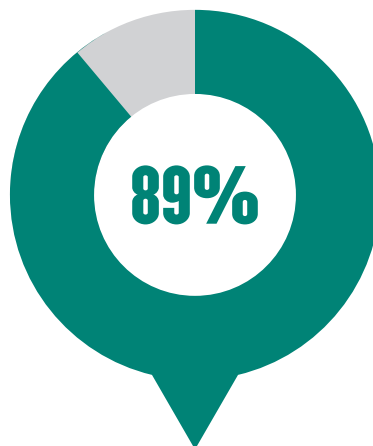

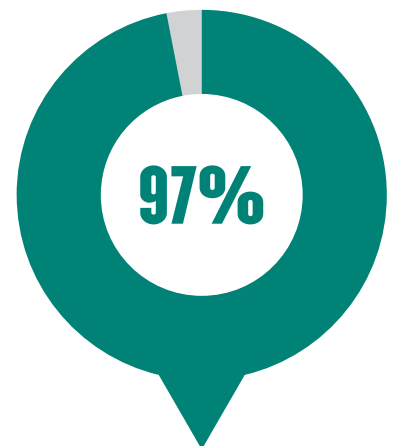

## ABOUT

Catholic Charities Edith Witt Senior Community located at 9th & Jessie Streets in San Francisco consists of 184 affordable apartments for low-income seniors built by Mercy Housing.

Catholic Charities provides a multitude of on-site and integrated services to this community. These services assist seniors in their progress towards stability: residential, financial and psycho-social. The services include on-site case management, crisis intervention and a host of senior-specific services, including intergenerational events and activities with Catholic Charities 10th & Mission Family Housing located next door. Tenants consistently volunteer for these events, demonstrating strong engagement with the community. The support services team offers linkage to mainstream benefits, coordination of services needed for seniors to age in place, including help to prevent eviction.

## SERVICES

- On-site case management
- Information, resources, and referral for community services
- Intergenerational community building activities and workshops for seniors
- Safe, supervised, and age-appropriate socialization opportunities that incorporate physical, emotional, and mental well being
- Community enrichment workshops from four service partners
